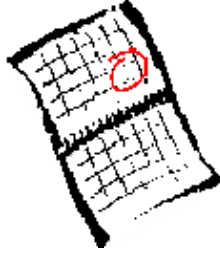

The American Red Cross is recruiting additional local volunteers for the Tahoe Truckee area. There are openings for Disaster Action Team members, instructors, outreach, special events, fund development, public affairs & leadership positions.

The Capital Region Chapter responded to more than 400 local disasters throughout our 11 county area last year, providing emergency shelter, food, clothing & supplies. Each year local Red Cross instructors certify nearly 60,000 people in CPR/AED, First aid, water safety, lifeguard training and disaster preparedness classes. Our Service to the Armed Forces program supports members of the military, providing comfort in hospitals and by providing emergency communications for families.

The Red Cross is a charitable organization not a government agency and depends on volunteers and the generosity of the American public to perform its mission.

These classes are required to become a Red Cross Volunteer. Our Disaster Team Training will be held January 28<sup>th</sup> 12-4 also in Truckee.**
