Economic Development Board Seeks Nonprofit, Education And Utility Reps

The Placer County Economic Development Board is seeking to fill three of its seats: a newly created position for a representative of local nonprofit organizations and soon-to-be vacant positions for education and utility representatives.

Placer County currently is seeking applications for all three positions. The deadline for applying is Nov. 23.

The Placer County Board of Supervisors will ultimately confirm appointments after nominations are approved by the Economic Development Board. Known informally as the EDB, the latter board is an advisory body that assists the county and local municipalities with their business attraction and retention efforts. It promotes the creation of new jobs and tax revenue and supports tourism, agribusiness, film production and workforce development initiatives. The two-year terms of the EDB's current education and utility representatives are set to expire at the end of the year. The terms of the three newly appointed members will begin Jan. 1, 2012 and end Dec. 31, 2013.

The EDB's quarterly meetings typically take place at 3 p.m. on the third Thursdays of January, April, June and September. At least one meeting is held at North Lake Tahoe each year.

PLACER COUNTY SUPERVISORS HOLD TAHOE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE HOMEWOOD PROJECT

At a special meeting in Tahoe City on Tuesday, November 15, the Placer County Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on a third-party appeal of a Planning Commission decision to approve the Homewood Mountain Resort Project. The Board heard from approximately 40 concerned members of the public who both spoke out in favor and against of the project. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Supervisors closed the hearing, but will allow the appellants to submit documents until November 28, 2011. Any additional information that is submitted by the appellants will be considered by the Board at its December 6, 2011 meeting. At that time, the Board will again take up the project at a regularly scheduled meeting in Auburn.

The project had previously been unanimously approved by both the Planning Commission and the North Tahoe Regional Advisory Council.

The Board continued the matter until its Dec. 6, 2011, meeting at the Planning Commission Chambers located in the Community Development Resource Center, located at 3091 County Center Drive, Auburn.
